MEMORANDUM


Complainant, a pro se litigant alleges that in recommending the dismissal of complainant's lawsuit and the imposition of sanctions, the subject United States Magistrate Judge erroneously cited two cases complainant filed in another federal district court and thereby "engag[ed] in a practice of LAZY review, and lack luster [sic] judicial practice, causing a delay in justice."

The allegation relates directly to the merits of the magistrate judge's decision and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.

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
ORDER
