
MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a *pro se* litigant, complains that in a report recommending dismissal of his claims, the subject United States Magistrate Judge “twist[ed] my words around in my case to where it sounds like I am making this up.”

The allegation relates directly to the merits of the magistrate judge’s report, and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
