### MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a state prisoner, complains that the subject United States Magistrate Judges issued reports erroneously summarizing certain facts of complainant's arrest and criminal conviction. He contends that the errors amount to "AGG perjury."

The allegations relate directly to the merits of the magistrate judges' decisions. With regard to Magistrate Judge A, the complaint is subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii). Magistrate Judge B's retirement several years ago is an intervening event that makes action on the allegations against him unnecessary, and the complaint proceeding as to Magistrate Judge B is therefore concluded pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(2).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
