MEMORANDUM


Complainant, a private citizen, complains that the subject United States District Judge “clearly is intentionally delaying” entering final judgment in a civil lawsuit in which a jury returned its verdict in September 2016.

A review of the docket indicates that jury verdict did not dispose of the litigation: the parties’ post-trial motions for judgment as a matter of law are pending before the court. The judge last entered an order in late March 2017, a mere two months before the instant complaint was filed.

There is no evidence of delay, intentional or otherwise, and the complaint is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
