MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a pro se litigant, has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the subject United States Magistrate Judge. In a brief statement of facts, complainant simply states: "Motion to dismiss allegations against Defendant A which there was evidence to support the lawsuit basis on the allegations of the abuse both children have encountered under [Defendant A]."

The complaint appears to relate directly to the merits of the magistrate judge's recommendations to grant the defendants' motions to dismiss complainant's claims and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
