
MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a state prisoner, alleges that the subject United States Magistrate Judge violated his constitutional rights by recommending that his habeas claims be dismissed “without the State explaining how did [my] [prisoner I.D. number] change” in the caption on a Certificate of Interested Persons. He further complains that the magistrate judge “refused to respond to a Writ of Quo Warranto forwarded to USDC from [the] County District Attorney’s Office.”

The allegations relate directly to the merits of the magistrate judge’s decisions and are therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
