
MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a pro se litigant that the subject United States Magistrate Judge “discriminated against on [sic] my case ... they did not allow my case to proceed properly because of court interference by court personnel. My case was prejudged.”

The complaint is subject to dismissal as frivolous under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii) because a review of the docket shows that the magistrate judge transferred the matter to another court division before complainant was purportedly added as a plaintiff.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
