M E M O R A N D U M

Complainant, a state death row inmate, has filed a barely intelligible complaint alleging misconduct by the subject United States District Judge in complainant's pending 28 U.S.C. § 2254 proceeding. Complainant alleges that the judge: "unlawfully allow[ed] the [State Attorney General] to change the cause of [the victim's] [sic] death . . . [The Attorney General's] corruption is tampering [sic] government record"; and "knows that the CIA and the FBI were "illegally experimenting" on me and my [im]mediate family, corrupt agents who are from [another State]."

To the extent that the allegations relate directly to the merits of decisions or procedural rulings, they are subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii). In other respects, the allegations appear frivolous and are therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
