

Complainant, a pro se litigant, has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against the subject United States Circuit Judge.¹ Complainant makes no specific allegations against the circuit judge, rather he requests an investigation into purported “Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court monitoring of,” and “rogue CIA/DOS/FBI/DOJ etc. espionage” related to, Ross Perot’s presidential campaigns in 1992 and 1996.

The complaint is frivolous and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
