MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a pro se litigant, has filed separate judicial misconduct complaints against three United States Circuit Judges, three Chief United States District Judges, and sixteen United States District Judges, all of whom were appointed to the federal bench by a former President of the United States. Complainant makes no specific allegations against the subject judges; rather he provides 167 pages of documents on the general topic of the alleged ineligibility for office of the former President and two United States Senators.¹

The consolidated complaint is frivolous and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
