MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a pro se litigant, has filed a complaint alleging misconduct by all members of the en banc Court of this Circuit for denying his petition for rehearing and petition for rehearing en banc. He claims that in doing so, they "committed cognizable misconduct by using their office to provide special favors for the Government attorneys."

The allegations relate directly to the merits of the en banc Court's ruling and are therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

To the extent that complainant alleges misconduct by a senior circuit judge who did not participate in the en banc Court, the allegation is subject to dismissal as frivolous under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

¹ Complainant identifies nineteen circuit judges, including two senior circuit judges, as the subjects of his complaint. A review of the record shows that only one of the senior circuit judges participated in the en banc Court.

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
