MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a pro se litigant, complains that in a civil proceeding the subject United States District Judge denied various motions. He appears to further allege that an order enjoining complainant from filing further motions without leave of the court constituted the judge's instructing "clerks to conceal and discard" motions complainant attempted to file thereafter. Complainant also appears to complain that the judge issued adverse rulings "in chambers with no parties present," thereby violating complainant's due process rights. Complainant submits that the judge showed "willfulness in not following the laws of the land [which] violates [complainant's] divine right by the Creator for due process of law."

These allegations relate directly to merits of decisions or procedural rulings and are therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.
