

## IN THE UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE FIFTH CIRCUIT

In the Matter of Adopting a Policy Governing Access, Services, and Conduct in the Library of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit Located in the Bob Casey Federal Courthouse in Houston, Texas.

## ORDER

The Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit has inherent authority to exercise control over access to its workplaces and avoid disruptions to the ability of the court and its employees to perform their duties. The library of the Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit located in the Bob Casey Federal Courthouse in Houston, Texas, is maintained solely for the purpose of supporting the judicial mission of the federal courts. Members of the Bar, employees of government agencies, and other members of the public are welcome to use the library for the purpose of conducting legal research, subject to library rules on access, services, and conduct. The Circuit Librarian for the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit shall have authority to issue policies governing the permissible access, services, and conduct of noncourt members, and shall have authority to amend such policies as necessary from time to time.
