This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by Emily M. Homer, PhD. for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that Emily M. Homer, PhD., an individual researcher associated with an educational institution, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Dr. Homer has shown that the defined research project is intended for scholarly research that is limited in scope and not intended for redistribution on the internet or for commercial purposes. Additionally, Dr. Homer has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Dr. Homer shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of researching the effectiveness of deferred prosecution and non-prosecution agreements in preventing recidivism. The ultimate goal of the research is to publish multiple manuscripts that will be submitted for publication in academic journals. Dr. Homer shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- I. this fee exemption applies only to Dr. Homer, and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- II. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;

- III. by accepting this exemption, Dr. Homer agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- IV. Dr. Homer is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases;
- V. this exemption is valid until August 1, 2021.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
