2. A limited amount of seating will be reserved for the press. To reserve a seat, you must contact Karen Price at 504-310-7629 or <u>karen price@ca5.uscourts.gov</u> before 11:00 a.m. CST on Friday, October 29, 2010. You will be required to produce your credentials in order to access a reserved seat.

3. Spectator seating in the courtroom is limited and will be assigned on a first-come basis. Admittance name tags will be distributed by the Marshal's Service on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor of the Bob Casey Federal Building, 515 Rusk Street, Houston, TX, beginning at 8:00 a.m. Once allowed into the courtroom, you must remain in your seat until the end of the hearing. No one will be allowed in the courtroom once all seats are allotted and filled. No standing will be allowed.

4. The digital recording of the argument will be available online within one hour of the argument concluding.

5. No one will be permitted to bring into the courtroom cameras, cell phones or other devices which could be used to transmit video or audio signals, or record the proceedings. Please leave these devices in your office, car, hotel, etc. If you attempt to enter with one of these devices, you may be denied entry to the courtroom.
