The writing sample should reflect only the applicant's writing and analytical skills, and the applicant should be prepared to discuss it if called for an interview. The writing sample should not exceed 15 pages. Law review articles are strongly discouraged.

Applicants may be requested to complete an on-site writing sample during the interview.

**Position Overview**

Staff attorneys work in a highly collegial environment. The position provides a unique opportunity to become acquainted with many areas of federal law.

**Representative Duties**

The Staff Attorneys' Office primarily screens direct criminal appeals, prisoner cases, and immigration cases. Staff attorneys write memoranda to the Court and draft opinions and orders. The work of staff attorneys is analogous to that of personal law clerks, except that the staff attorneys work for the Court as a whole, rather than for individual judges. Other duties as assigned.

## **Conditions of Employment**

U.S. citizenship required, or must meet requirements under current law. Positions with the U.S. Courts are excepted service appointments, or “*at will*.” The initial appointment is provisional and contingent upon satisfactory completion of a background investigation. Direct deposit of pay required.

## **Benefits**

Although not civil service employees, term federal court employees share in most of the federal fringe benefit programs, including paid leave, holidays, health insurance, life insurance, long-term care insurance, vision and dental insurance.
