PER CURIAM:\*

Willie Chester, federal prisoner No. 56341-080, appeals the district court's denial of a 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition challenging Chester's 1992 Western District of Texas convictions and sentences as a career criminal for possession of a firearm by a felon and for making false statements in connection with the acquisition of a firearm. The district court denied relief because it determined

that Chester's claims sounded as an unauthorized second or successive 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion and found that Chester had not made the showing necessary to seek 28 U.S.C. § 2241 relief by means of the savings clause of 28 U.S.C. § 2255. Because Chester does not challenge this determination by the district court, he has waived the only issue relevant to his appeal. *Yohey v. Collins*, 985 F.2d 222, 225 (5th Cir. 1993).

AFFIRMED.
