PER CURIAM:*

The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Fidel Torres-Torres has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Torres-Torres has not filed a response. He has been released from prison and has no additional term of supervised release or payment of a fine or special assessment. We have reviewed counsel’s brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected therein. We concur with counsel’s assessment that the

appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED in part as frivolous, *see* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2, and in part as moot, *see United States v. Rosenbaum-Alanis*, 483 F.3d 381, 382-83 (5th Cir. 2007).
