PER CURIAM:*

Appellant appeals the sentencing portion of his conviction for possession with intent to distribute cocaine. He argues that the district court erred: (1) in denying him a downward adjustment for his minimal or minor role in the offense; (2) in denying him a downward adjustment for his acceptance of responsibility; and (3) in determining his criminal history score
