PER CURIAM:*

Julian Robles, Texas prisoner #625056, appeals the judgment of the district court dismissing his civil rights action as frivolous pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(i). He argues that he was denied parole in violation of his right of due process. We have reviewed the record and Robles' brief and AFFIRM the district court's dismissal for essentially the reasons
