Appellants Geraci, Collara, and Chalmette Jewelry, Inc. were found guilty by a jury under 18 U.S.C. § 371 for conspiring to violate the federal firearms law and under 18 U.S.C. § 922(d) for selling firearms and ammunition to a convicted felon. Appellants assign numerous points of error on appeal including *Brady*, search

warrant, Grand Jury and Confrontation Clause issues, as well as prosecutorial misconduct, and insufficiency of evidence claims.
