PER CURIAM:*

Claudis Dean Carrington, a Texas state prisoner, appeals from the district court's grant of summary judgment to the defendants in his civil rights suit. Carrington has filed with this court a request to proceed in forma pauperis (IFP) on appeal. Carrington argues that the defendants denied him adequate medical care after he fell from a top bunk bed while incarcerated at the Chambers County Jail. We have reviewed the

record and conclude that Carrington has not demonstrated that he will present a nonfrivolous issue on appeal. Accordingly, Carrington's motion to proceed IFP on appeal is DENIED and the appeal is DISMISSED. See Carson v. Polley, 689 F.2d 562, 586 (5th Cir. 1982); 5th Cir. R. 42.2.
