PER CURIAM:*

Mohammed Maksuour Rahman, Texas inmate #660008, challenges the grant of summary judgment for Defendants Hubbard and Mann. Rahman waived any appellate contention he might have urged concerning the dismissal of Defendants Browne and King. See *Evans v. City of Marlin, Tex.*, 986 F.2d 104, 106 n.1 (5th Cir. 1993) (issues not raised or briefed are considered abandoned).
