PER CURIAM:*

Richard Grey Kirby, #23415-077, appeals the district court's denial of his motion to alter or amend judgment in a § 1983/Bivens action. To the extent Kirby argues that the district court failed to address his Anti-Injunction Act claim, any error was harmless as he failed to show that he was entitled to an injunction under any exceptions to the general prohibition on

injunctions. See J.R. Clearwater Inc. v. Ashland Chemical Co.,
93 F.3d 176, 178-79 (5th Cir. 1996). We affirm in all other
respects for the same reasons stated by the district court.
