PER CURIAM:*

M.R. Mikkilineni seeks to appeal in forma pauperis (IFP) the district court's dismissal of his complaint. Mikkilineni has failed to comply with this court's May 19, 1999, order to pay a \$105 sanction. On July 12, 1999, this court ordered that

Mikkilineni was prohibited from filing "any civil appeal or other civil filing in this court unless he obtains written permission to do so from a judge of this court" until he pays the \$105 sanction. Mikkilineni has not paid the \$105 sanction, and he has not requested leave to file the instant IFP motion. Accordingly, Mikkilineni's appeal is DISMISSED. 5TH CIR. R. 42.3.1.2. The clerk of this court is directed to return unfiled any submission that is inconsistent with this order. The appellees' motion to dismiss is DENIED as moot.
