PER CURIAM:*

Daniel Isidro Sotelo-Lopez (Sotelo), federal inmate # 01763-180, sought habeas corpus relief from his conviction and sentence for marijuana and cocaine offenses that violated 21 U.S.C. §§ 841 and 846. Sotelo appeals the district court's denial of his motion for reconsideration of its order construing Sotelo's application for habeas relief as a 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion. The order that Sotelo asked the district court to reconsider is not a final judgment. See Silver Star Enters., Inc., v. M/V SARAMACCA,

19 F.3d 1008, 1013 (5th Cir. 1994). Therefore, the district court's denial of Sotelo's motion for reconsideration is non-appealable. See 28 U.S.C. § 1291.

Accordingly, Sotelo's appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction.
