Suhaebah Sukari Kasim, a native and citizen of Indonesia, petitions for review of the final order of the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) affirming the decision of the Immigration Judge (IJ) denying her application for asylum as untimely and denying withholding of removal under the Immigration and Nationality Act. This court lacks jurisdiction to consider the BIA's determination that Kasim filed an untimely asylum

application and failed to meet an exception for waiving the deadline. See 8 U.S.C. § 1158(a)(3).

The BIA's affirmance of the IJ's denial of withholding of removal is supported by substantial evidence. <u>See INS v.</u> <u>Elias-Zacarias</u>, 502 U.S. 478, 483-84 (1992); <u>see also</u> <u>Carbajal-Gonzalez v. INS</u>, 78 F.3d 194, 197 (5th Cir. 1996).

Kasim has not briefed the denial of her claim under the Convention Against Torture, and that issue is abandoned. <u>See</u> <u>Yohey v. Collins</u>, 985 F.2d 222, 224-25 (5th Cir. 1993).
