The district court's decision rests upon its conclusion that Droulia has not rebutted the presumption that no condition or combination of conditions will reasonably assure her appearance as required. <u>See</u> 18 U.S.C. § 3142(e) & (f). The district court's conclusion is supported by the record. <u>See United</u> <u>States v. Rueben</u>, 974 F.2d 580, 586 (5th Cir. 1992). Accordingly
