Rickie Lynn Graves, Texas prisoner # 645074, seeks a certificate of appealability (COA) to appeal the district court's denial of his motion for leave to file a 28 U.S.C. § 2254 application. Graves had previously been sanctioned by a 29 August 1994 order prohibiting him from filing any lawsuits in the Northern District of Texas without first obtaining permission of a district judge.

The district court denied Graves' motion, stating that he had failed to *show cause* why the sanctions should be lifted and that his proposed 28 U.S.C. § 2254 application would be time-barred pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2244(d).

Because Graves has failed to show on appeal why the sanctions order should *not* apply, we uphold the sanctions order and **DENY** his request for a COA.
