Gregory A. Willis appeals from summary judgment upholding a National Railway Adjustment Board arbitral award. We affirm the judgment of the district court for the following reasons: (1) the board complied with all requirements of the Railway Labor Act; (2) it acted within the scope of its jurisdiction; and (3) there is no evidence of fraud or corruption. Our review is limited to these grounds. See 45 U.S.C. § 153 First (q); Union Pacific R.R. Co. v. Sheehan, 439 U.S. 89, 93 (1978). AFFIRMED.
