PER CURIAM:*

Court-appointed counsel for Felix Gonzalez, Jr., has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief as required by Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Gonzalez has responded, requesting to retain his counsel or to have new counsel appointed to represent him. Gonzalez also argues that one of his prior convictions was improperly considered at sentencing; his offense level should not have been increased two points for his playing a supervisory or managerial role; and he should have been given a

three-level decrease for acceptance of responsibility, rather than a two-level decrease.

Our independent review of the brief, Gonzalez' responses, and the record, including the waiver-of-appeal provision in the plea agreement, discloses no nonfrivolous issues for appeal.

Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. See 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
