PER CURIAM:*

Plaintiff-appellant waited almost three years after he left his job to file an EEOC charge of age discrimination. The EEOC dismissed the charge because it was not filed within the time limit required by law. Plaintiff-appellant then filed suit in the district court. When the Report and Recommendation of the magistrate judge was issued, the plaintiff-appellant was given an opportunity to set forth in his objections to the Report and Recommendation any facts not mentioned in his complaint that he contended provided grounds for equitable tolling. He failed to

do so, and the district court dismissed his complaint as time-barred. We have reviewed his brief, and we find there no reason to disturb the district court's judgment.
