purposes of the above-referenced litigation. Lloyd has also filed a Motion for Summary Reversal and Designation of Orders on Appeal.

Lloyd's *nunc pro tunc* motion was an unauthorized motion, which the district court should have dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. <u>See United States v. Early</u>, 27 F.3d 140, 142 (5th Cir. 1994). We affirm the judgment on this alternative basis. <u>See id.</u> Lloyd's Motion for Summary Reversal and Designation of Orders on Appeal is denied.
