PER CURTAM:*

In 1992, Thomas Cipriano, federal prisoner # 23148-034, was convicted by a jury of conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute and attempt to possess with intent to distribute cocaine and was sentenced to life imprisonment. The district court dismissed his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition, determining that Cipriano had not satisfied the criteria to support his claims under the savings clause of 28 U.S.C. § 2255.

Cipriano's brief does not address the district court's conclusion that he did not meet the criteria for raising his claims in this 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition pursuant to the savings clause of 28 U.S.C. § 2255. Thus, he has abandoned the only issue on appeal by failing to brief it. Brinkmann v. Dallas County Deputy Sheriff Abner, 813 F.2d 744, 748 (5th Cir. 1987).

The district court's dismissal of Cipriano's 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition is AFFIRMED.
