Michael John Gilbert, <u>pro</u> <u>se</u>, appeals the magistrate judge's order denying appointed counsel in this Title VII action. Although Gilbert consented to final disposition by a magistrate judge, Val Verde Regional Medical Center did not consent. Gilbert did not seek review of the magistrate judge's ruling by the district court. Accordingly, we lack appellate jurisdiction to review the magistrate judge's order. <u>See Singletary v. B.R.X., Inc.</u>, 828 F.2d 1135, 1137 (5th Cir. 1987) (pretrial matters referred by a district
