PER CURIAM:*

Court-appointed counsel for Juan Valente Sillero-Llanos (Sillero) has moved for leave to withdraw from this appeal of the revocation of Sillero's probation and has filed a brief as required by Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). In response, Sillero has filed various motions requesting, *inter alia*, the appointment of counsel, discovery, and a stay of the execution of his sentence.

Our independent review of the brief, Sillero's motions, and the record discloses no nonfrivolous issue for appeal. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the appeal is DISMISSED. See 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. Sillero's motions are DENIED.
