PER CURIAM:*

Sunday Olakanpo Olasebikan, Federal prisoner # 04895-078, has appealed the dismissal, pursuant to Immigration and Nationality Act ("INA") § 242(a)(2)(B), of his petition for a writ of habeas corpus, under 28 U.S.C. § 2241, challenging the affirmance by the Bureau of Immigration Appeals of the denial of his application under INA § 212(c) for waiver of deportation. Because Olasebikan has departed from the United States, we lack

jurisdiction and the appeal must be dismissed. See 8 U.S.C.
§ 1105a(c) (1994); see also Cipriano v. INS, 24 F.3d 763, 764
(5th Cir. 1994).
