The attorney appointed to represent Martin Alejandro Meza-Sanchez (Meza) has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Meza has filed a response. The record is insufficiently developed to allow consideration at this time of Meza's claims of ineffective assistance of counsel. See *United States v. Cantwell*, 470 F.3d 1087, 1091 (5th Cir. 2006). Our independent review of the record, counsel's

brief, and Meza's response discloses no nonfrivolous issue for appeal. Accordingly, the motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. See 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
