We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeals present no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEALS ARE DISMISSED. See 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. Gonzalez's motion for authorization to proceed pro se on appeal is DENIED. See *United States v. Wagner*, 158 F.3d 901, 902-03 (5th Cir. 1998).
