PER CURIAM:*

Eulogio Valentin Torres-Orellana, federal prisoner # 55895-112, an alien against whom the Bureau of Immigration and Customs Enforcement has issued a detainer subjecting him to immediate removal from the United States upon release from Bureau of Prisons (BOP) custody, moves this court to proceed in forma pauperis (IFP) to appeal the denial of his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition

challenging the BOP's exclusion of him from rehabilitation programs and halfway houses. His arguments are foreclosed by this court's decision in *Gallegos-Hernandez v. United States*, 688 F.3d 190, 194-96 (5th Cir.), *cert. denied*, 133 S. Ct. 561 (2012).

Accordingly, Torres-Orellana's motion to proceed IFP is DENIED, and his appeal is DISMISSED as frivolous. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
