The attorney appointed to represent Anastacio Aranda Soto has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Aranda Soto has not filed a response, has completed the confinement portion of his sentence, and has been removed from the United

States. We have reviewed counsel's brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected therein. We concur with counsel's assessment that Aranda Soto's appeal of his conviction presents no nonfrivolous issue. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED in part as frivolous, *see* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2, and in part as moot, *see United States v. Rosenbaum-Alanis*, 483 F.3d 381, 382-83 (5th Cir. 2007).
