Appealing the judgment in a criminal case, Raymond Easias Fisk raises an argument that he concedes is foreclosed by *United States v. Alcantar*, 733 F.3d 143, 145-46 (5th Cir. 2013). In *Alcantar*, we rejected the argument that *Nat'l Fed'n of Indep. Bus. v. Sebelius*, 132 S. Ct. 2566 (2012), affected our prior jurisprudence rejecting challenges to the constitutionality of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(1). 733 F.3d at 146. The Government's unopposed motion for
