PER CURIAM:*

The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Reino Herrera-Garcia has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Herrera-Garcia filed a motion for appointment of counsel on appeal but has not filed a response to the *Anders* motion. We have reviewed counsel's brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected

therein, as well as Herrera-Garcia's motion. We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, Herrera-Garcia's motion for appointment of counsel is DENIED, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR.
