PER CURIAM:*

Raul Palacios-Garcia appeals the sentence imposed following his guilty plea conviction for illegal reentry following a previous deportation. He argues that the district court erred in imposing an obstruction-of-justice enhancement and in refusing to apply the acceptance-of-responsibility reduction. In addition, he argues that the district court's denial of his motion to file out-of-time objections to the presentence report was an abuse of discretion.

Palacios-Garcia has completed his term of imprisonment, has been released from custody, and has been removed to Mexico. The appeal of his sentence is therefore moot. *See United States v. Rosenbaum-Alanis*, 483 F.3d 381, 382-83 (5th Cir. 2007).
