instant appeal is moot. See Spencer v. Kemna, 523 U.S. 1, 7 (1998); United States v. Heredia-Holguin, 823 F.3d 337, 343 (5th Cir. 2016) (en banc).

Accordingly, Ayala-Ayala's appeal is DISMISSED as moot.
