We lack jurisdiction because the order denying his motion to appoint counsel is not an appealable interlocutory order. *See Williams v. Catoe*, 946 F.3d 278, 279-81 (5th Cir. 2020) (en banc).

The appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction.
