Because no additional term of supervised release was imposed, this appeal is moot. *See Spencer v. Kemna*, 523 U.S. 1, 7-8, 12-14 (1998). Accordingly, the appeal is DISMISSED as moot, and counsel's motion to withdraw is DENIED as unnecessary.
