PER CURIAM:*

George Loyd's cause of action accrued no later than January 22, 1990. Burrell v. Newsome, 883 F.2d 416, 418 (5th Cir. 1989). This suit, filed on December 20, 1991, is therefore time-barred. Ali v. Higgs, 892 F.2d 438, 439 (5th Cir. 1990); LA. CIV. CODE ANN. art. 3492 (West Supp. 1992). Since the suit lacks an arguable legal basis, its dismissal as frivolous was within the
