The Supreme Court's decision in <u>St. Mary's Honor Center v. Hicks</u>, 509 U.S. ____, 113 S. Ct. 2742 (1993) does not conflict with the trial court's ruling.

Appellant's "evidence" simply raised no genuine issue of material fact as to whether defendant intentionally discriminated against him because of his age.
