Cassandra Turner sued her former employer for discrimination. After a bench trial, the district court entered detailed findings of fact and conclusions of law, deciding that there was no discrimination.

transcript. Nor has she presented, in any coherent or understandable way, any issues or argument on appeal. We can only assume she is challenging the district court's findings and conclusions, but we have no way to review them without a transcript of the trial proceedings.

The appeal, accordingly, is frivolous. It is DISMISSED pursuant to 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
